

## Serge Bellanger

Born on April 30, 1933 in Vimoutiers (Orne) in France, Serge Bellanger is a President of the French-American Chamber of Commerce in the U.S. as well as the New York Chapter. He is also a President of UCCIFE (l'Union des Chambres de Commerce et d'Industrie Françaises à l'Étranger), the international network of French overseas Chambers of Commerce. Mr. Bellanger is an Executive Vice President and General Manager of the New York branch of CIC-Credit Industriel et Commercial.

He was made an Officier de la Légion d'honneur (Officer of the Legion of Honor) in 1995 and a Commandeur de l'Ordre national du Mérite (National Order of Merit) in 1998. In 2000 he was appointed a member of AFE group: UFE-DIL (Union des Français de l'étranger Démocrates, Indépendants et Libéraux).

He also serves as an administrator of Comité National des Conseillers du Commerce Extérieur de la France and the Centre Français du Commerce Extérieur. He is a President of the consulting committee of the Maison Française de Columbia University and the Centre d'Études Françaises à New York, consulting committee member of the Lycée de New York, partner of the New York City Partnership and a Committee member of the Direction de la Fédération des Anciens Combattants Français
